## POWER: AAC OVERVIEW

POWER: AAC is a series of modules, written and presented by Gail Van Tatenhove, MS, CCC-SLP, designed to build the capacity of those who serve students with complex communication needs, who require the use of augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) systems. The modules focus on providing modeling and teaching the use of powerful, flexible core vocabulary, and are appropriate for professional learning community use.

### What Does "Power AAC" Mean?

The title POWER AAC refers to the five key principles of this project. POWER AAC classrooms have educational teams who are learning to:

Practice powerful communication **PARTNER** skills.  
Create powerful communication **OPPORTUNITIES**.

Implement power **WORDS** in social and instructional contexts.

Continually utilize **EVIDENCE** in decision making about AAC systems and supports.

Create, implement, and share powerful **RESOURCES**.
